1. What is Medi+?

Medi+ is a web-based service that helps people with taking and managing their medications. It is a service provided by Zur Rose Suisse AG (hereinafter referred to as "Zur Rose"), which ÖKK insured persons who have basic KVG insurance and live in Switzerland can use voluntarily and free of charge.

To use Medi+, the ÖKK insured persons sign a user agreement with Zur Rose when they register for Medi+. The Terms and Conditions of Use of Zur Rose apply exclusively. ÖKK accepts no liability or responsibility with regard to the use of Medi+ by ÖKK insured persons.

The use of Medi+ has no effects on the payment or processing of benefits under the basic KVG insurance. There is no obligation to purchase medications via the Zur Rose mail order pharmacy.

2. What are the requirements for using Medi+?

The requirements for full use of Medi+ are:

- Agreement to the electronic transfer of medication data from ÖKK to Zur Rose. This agreement can only be provided from the ÖKK customer portal (myÖKK) and must be provided individually for each person.
 - An active Medi+ customer account with Zur Rose
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3. What is the purpose of data transfer to Medi+?

With their electronic agreement in the myÖKK customer portal, the insured persons instruct ÖKK to transfer data about invoiced medications anonymously to Medi+. This transfer means that they do not have to enter data manually when opening and using Medi+.

After the insured persons have successfully registered with Medi+, medication data is automatically transferred from ÖKK to Zur Rose within a maximum of eight days and displayed and saved in the corresponding Medi+ customer account. The medication data is supplemented regularly (normally weekly) with data from ÖKK's benefit invoices.

4. Which data is transferred from ÖKK to Zur Rose?

After the insured person has registered for data transfer and with Medi+, the following data is transferred to Zur Rose:

- Medication data from submitted benefit invoices: name of the medication, package size, number of units, prescribing doctor, source (pharmacy, doctor), purchase date, purchase amount, ÖKK invoice date.

The medication data for the preceding six months and the current master data are transmitted as part of the first data transfer. After that, the medication data submitted to ÖKK for settlement during the period in question is transferred on a regular basis. ÖKK ensures that the data is only available to Zur Rose for the purpose of transferring it to Medi+.

5. What happens after deregistration from data transfer with ÖKK?

If insured persons deregister from data transfer, ÖKK forwards this information to Medi+ and discontinues the data transfer. The Medi+ account continues to exist. The termination/deactivation of the Medi+ account is carried out in accordance with Zur Rose's terms and conditions of use for Medi+.

6. What happens after the termination/deactivation of the Medi+ account with Zur Rose?

If the user terminates the Medi+ account with Zur Rose or if Zur Rose deactivates the account, Zur Rose shall inform ÖKK of this. In this case, the agreement to the data transfer is deactivated by ÖKK and data transfer to Zur Rose is discontinued immediately.

7. In which cases is data transfer discontinued by ÖKK?

The data transfer from ÖKK to Zur Rose is discontinued in the following cases:

- When the user deactivates data transfer in the myÖKK customer portal
 - When the Medi+ account with Zur Rose is terminated or deactivated
 - When the user's basic KVG insurance with ÖKK is terminated
 - When the user deletes/deactivates the myÖKK account
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8. What happens to the transferred data after data transfer comes to an end?

According to Zur Rose's terms and conditions of use, data that has already been transferred is retained and can continue to be used. No more new data will be transferred from the date on which data transfer was deactivated.

9. Which Medi+ data does ÖKK receive from Zur Rose?

- ÖKK receives a notification that the Medi+ account has been deactivated.
 - Anonymised usage statistics that cannot be allocated to individual users.
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10. Which additional requirements must be adhered to?

These terms and conditions of use of ÖKK only apply to data transfer by ÖKK. Data processing by Zur Rose on Medi+ and the use of Medi+ by ÖKK's insured persons is based exclusively on Zur Rose's terms and conditions of use for Medi+.

ÖKK reserves the right to discontinue data transfer to Medi+ and the Medi+ service for its customers at any time without indicating its reasons for doing so. It may also restrict the use of certain functions or expand the existing functions.
